


DRIVING ENERGY TRANSITION, SECURITY AND DECARBONISATION

Held under the patronage and attendance of His Excellency Abdel Fattah El Sisi, President of the Arab Republic of Egypt, and supported by the Ministry of Petroleum and Mineral Resources, the Egypt Energy Show took place in Cairo from 19 - 21 February, bringing together the ambitions, actions, technology and investment needed to advance the energy transition, and showcase Egypt's progress as the energy hub of the region, representing a unifying voice for Africa's energies of the future.

Held under the theme 'Driving energy transition, security and decarbonisation', EGYPES 2024 was uniquely positioned as the platform for energy and related industries to demonstrate their commitment to lowering emissions while supporting industry growth and economic progress.

The Egypt Energy Show continues to be at the heart of the dynamic, fast changing energy conversation, having welcomed an unprecedented 43,600+ attendees, 300+ global speakers - including ministers, global CEOs, policymakers, innovators and future leaders, as well as 450+ companies from across the energy value chain to meet, connect and explore action-oriented roadmaps for development and shared progress.







The conference gathered energy leaders, sustainable finance and climate experts to assess the economic uncertainties facing global economies in leveraging financial mechanisms and capital market tools to deliver future energy systems.

Global energy markets are having to learn to adapt in today's everchanging industry landscape, which is striving for cleaner energy, facing geopolitical constraints, and unprecedented inflation rates.

The increased urgency of the climate crisis has accelerated calls to action for the energy sector to accelerate decarbonisation activities over the next decade and achieve meaningful targets by 2030. With the global energy mix shifting from fossil fuel-based systems of energy production and consumption to renewable energy sources, an estimated \$200 trillion in global investments needed to reach net-zero emissions by 2050.

Despite renewable energies gaining momentum, they still only account for approximately 6% of the world's energy consumption. Global energy demand is anticipated to rise through 2050 with oil remaining the largest energy source, investment in oil and gas projects and infrastructure will therefore be vital in ensuring affordable and reliable energy supply throughout this transitional period. Furthermore, geopolitical tensions continue to underline the importance of a more gradual transition, both for energy security and environmental reasons.



As we navigate the transition towards a more sustainable future, collaboration between governments, businesses, and communities will be key.



The inaugural conference brought together key African stakeholders including top government officials, financial institutions, economists and energy thought leaders to discuss the most pressing challenges related to policies, regulations and natural gas infrastructure development.

Africa's population is expected to double by 2050, as a result the continents energy demand is expected to increase tremendously in the next two decades. Despite possessing 8% of the world's proven natural gas reserves, more than 700 million Africans lack access to energy and clean cooking fuels.

In accordance with the Paris Agreement, the transition away from fossil fuels has been at the centre of the global climate conversation. Despite contributing the least to global warming and emitting the lowest greenhouse gases, Africa is the most vulnerable to climate change.

Given that African economies are heavily dependent on oil and gas export revenues, fossil fuels will continue to maintain a prominent role in the region's energy mix. While African nations have demonstrated ambition in playing a crucial role in global efforts to combat climate change, Africa must take a pragmatic approach that assures a gradual shift from fossil fuels to clean energy sources.

As the energy transition accelerates, fuelled by groundbreaking clean energy technologies, the global spotlight on talent strategy intensifies. This has increased pressure in the industry to recruit, retain, and upskill existing talent to bridge skill gaps, exacerbated by retiring professionals leaving the sector, digital transformation creating new roles, and talent drain to technology sectors.

Navigating the energy transition and attaining net zero targets by 2050 will be a generational challenge, with STEM millennial and Gen Z graduates of today, being the energy leaders of tomorrow. With this in mind, the sector is actively redefining itself to be an attractive career proposition for the next generation of talent. From creating flexible working environments which offer employees better work life balance to fostering a culture of purpose that aligns with their values.

Despite evidence clearly demonstrating that a diverse and inclusive workforce fosters profit and innovation, yet only a tiny proportion of women continue to enter the energy industry in spite of a large cohort of STEM graduates. Creating a diverse and inclusive workforce remains a strategic necessity to enable a low carbon future.


